

## **CALL FOR PAPERS**

***The RDWU Journal of Social Sciences and Humanities*** is an interdisciplinary research journal of the Rama Devi Women's University, Bhubaneswar, India. It is established with the goal to advance new frontiers of academic enquiry. By providing an open forum for critical exchange, the journal seeks to enlarge and enrich interdisciplinary discourse in social sciences. The journal welcomes articles based on original research that are not previously published for its fourth issue.

Following are the instructions for paper contributors:

### **Instructions to Contributors**

1. Submission of articles should be in English/Odia typed in double-spacing on one side of the paper only in A4 size.
2. Articles on Odia Literature might be submitted in Odia language.
3. Length of articles should be limited to 5000 words.
3. Articles should follow the format of title, abstract, keywords (5-6) and then main article. Name of author should be below the title of the article (middle aligned).
4. An Asterisk should be placed on top of the author name and below the first page, the author designation and affiliation should be written (Refer to sample attached).
5. Font to be followed is Times New Roman or Arial.
6. Title of the article should have font size 14.
7. Author name should have font size 12.
8. Abstract should have font size 11.
9. Keywords should have font size 12.
10. Contributions will be considered for publication only on the understanding that they are not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
11. Papers will be double-blind peer-reviewed.
12. The contributors should follow MLA Style Book 8<sup>th</sup> edition.
13. The journal follows the endnote pattern; serialise all explanatory notes in the sequence in which they are referred to in the text (using numbered superscripts) and place them at the end of the text under notes, but before References, Endnotes must not be used for bibliographic purposes.
14. Cite sentences or words taken from other works within single quotation marks; use double quotation mark only within quotations. Separate quotations exceeding 50 words from the text and indent them on the left. Unless the entire sentence is part of the quotation, the punctuation must remain outside the quotation marks.
