NOTIFICATION

Consequent upon the resolution of the Examination Committee and approval of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, dated 09.04.2021 the guidelines for Publication of results of UG 2nd Semester & 4th Semester Examination, 2020 and PG 2nd Semester Examination, 2020 are notified herewith.

The results of the students will be published in the **alternative evaluation method** with reference to the letter no.28335/HE dtd.02.09.2020 of DHE, Govt. of Odisha and in conformity to UGC guidelines April, 2020.

As per item No. B (2) of DHE, guideline, Annexure-I, those students who have filled up their forms to appear the UG 2nd and 4th Semester Examination, 2020 shall be considered for accord of marks and grades.

As per item A(2) and A(3) of (Annexure-I), those students who have filled up their forms to appear at the PG 2nd Semester Examination, 2020, shall be considered for award of marks and grades as per the following method.

ALTERNATIVE EVALUATION METHOD FOR UG

Intermediate Semesters of Under Graduate Regular Examination, 2020 (4th Semester for 2018 Admission Batch & 2nd Semester for 2019 Admission Batch)

For Subjects without Practical

- Internal marks secured as per the prescribed weightage (**out of 20**)

+

- Average of End Sem. marks obtained in all previous Semesters in all Papers of different Subject categories like CORE, SEC, DSC-1/2/3, GE, AECC will be awarded against the Paper(s) of that Subject category as per the prescribed weightage (**out of 80**)

Average of End Sem. Marks = $\frac{\text{Total marks secured}}{\text{Maximum marks}} \times 80$

Maximum marks X 80

e.g. For 4th Semester

(FM=80 for one paper)

End-Sem. marks = Sum of the marks secured in End-Sem. of
in each paper

C-I to C-VII **X 80**

560 (sum of the Max. marks of End-Sem.)

For 2nd Semester

(FM=80 for one paper)

End-Sem. marks = Sum of the marks secured in End-Sem. of
in each paper

C-I & C-II **X 80**

160 (sum of the Max. marks of End-Sem.)

(ii) **For Subjects with Practical**

- Internal marks secured as per the prescribed weightage (out of 15)

+

- Average of End Sem marks obtained in all previous Semesters in all Papers of different Subject categories like CORE,DSC,AECC,SEC,GE will be awarded against the Papers of that subject categories as per the prescribed weightage. (out of 60)

+

Practical marks secured as per the prescribed weightage (out of 25)

$$\text{Average of End Sem Marks} = \frac{\text{Total marks secured}}{\text{Maximum marks}} \times 60$$

e.g. **For 4th Semester**

(FM=60 for one paper)

$$\text{End-Sem. marks} = \frac{\text{Sum of the marks secured in End-Sem. of in each paper C-I to C-VII}}{420 \text{ (sum of the Max.marks of End-Sem.)}} \times 60$$

For 2nd Semester

(FM=60 for one paper)

$$\text{End-Sem. marks} = \frac{\text{Sum of the marks secured in End-Sem. of in each Paper C-I \& C-II}}{120 \text{ (sum of the Max.marks of End-Sem.)}} \times 60$$

Elaborations:

1. Average of the marks secured in End Semester of all Core Papers from Core-I to Core-VII will be posted as End Semester mark in Core-VIII,IX & X for 4th Semester Examination,2020 (Admission Batch 2018).
2. Average of the marks secured in End Semester of all Core Papers from Core-I & C-II will be posted as the End Semester mark in Core-III & C-IV for 2nd Semester Examination,2020 (Admission Batch 2019).
3. In case of Practical Marks for Core-VIII,IX & X(for 4th Sem.2020) or Core-III & C-IV Practical (for 2nd Sem.Exam.2020) will be the average of the marks secured in Practical Papers in all previous Semesters (i.e. average of the practical marks of Core-I to C-VII for 4th Semester and average of Practical marks of C-I & C-II for 2nd Semester).
4. For Arts (Pass) marks scored in DSC-1A shall be considered for posted in End-Semester marks of DSC-1B in 2nd Semester Examination,2020 (2019 Adm. Batch)
 - Similarly marks scored in DSC-2A shall be considered for End-Semester marks of DSC-2B for 2nd Semester Examination,2020 (2019 Adm. Batch)
 - For Science (pass) marks scored in DSC-1A,DSC-2A,DSC-3A will be considered for End-Semester marks of DSC-1B,DSC-2B,DSC-3B respectively for 2nd Semester examination,2020 (2019 Adm. Batch).

5. For Arts/Sc. (Pass) students, average of the marks scored in End-semester of DSC-1A,DSC-1B,DSC-1C will be posted as the End-Semester marks of DSC-1D in 4th Semester,2020 (2018 Adm. Batch)
 - For Arts / Sc. (Pass) students, average of the marks scored in End-semester of DSC-2A,DSC-2B,DSC-2C will be posted as the End-Semester marks of DSC-2D in 4th Semester,2020 (2018 Adm. Batch)
 - For Science (Pass) students, average of the marks scored in End-semester of DSC-3A,DSC-3B,DSC-3C will be posted as the End-Semester marks of DSC-1D,DSC-2D,DSC-3D in 4th Semester,2020 (2018 Adm. Batch)
6. In case of marks for SEC-II,GE-B-II in 4th Semester, marks secured in End Semester of corresponding course category SEC-I and GE-B-I (in 3rd Sem) will be considered.
7. Similarly for marks for AECC-II, GEA-II in 2nd Semester; Marks secured in End Semester of corresponding subject category AECC-I & GE-A-I (in 1st Sem.) will be considered .
8. If a candidate is absent in End-Semester of any paper of a particular course category like (GE/AECC/SEC) in previous semester, marks secured in mid-Semester shall be proportionately converted to marks for End Sem.
9. **For Commerce (Hons) students**
 - (a) In Core-X, which is a paper with Practical; marks in Theory (End Sem.=60) & Practical (FM:-25) will be given by proportionate calculation from the average of all the Core Papers i.e. from C-I to C-VII.
 - (b) Average of End-Semester marks in GE-I,GE-II,GE-III shall be posted as the End-Semester marks in GE-IV (4th Semester).
10. For compulsory papers in Arts(Pass) marks secured in End-Semester of MIL-I for 1st Semester will be posted in MIL-II for 2nd Sem,2020 (2019 Adm.Batch) and marks secured in English-I 2nd Semester,2019 shall be posted in English-II for 4thSemester ,2020 (2018 Adm. Batch)

N.B. : But if a candidate is absent in the mid-Sem. & End-Sem. of that paper then the result of the candidate will remain withheld. If a candidate is absent in any Core-paper, then average of all other Core-papers appeared shall be considered.

ALTERNATIVE EVALUATION METHOD FOR PG

Intermediate Semesters of Post Graduate Examination, 2020 (Admission Batch 2019)

- Internal marks secured as per the prescribed weightage (Out of 20)

+

As per the point B(2) of DHE guidelines, Annexure-I, the following alternative method is adopted for intermediate semesters.

- Average of the marks secured in End Semester of all the Hard Core Papers of PG 1st Semester, will be awarded against the End Semester papers of PG 2nd Semester irrespective of the subject category (HC/AE)

Average of End Sem. Marks = $\frac{\text{Total marks secured}}{\text{Maximum marks}} \times 80$

(FM=80 for one paper)

Average of End-Sem. marks = $\frac{\text{Sum of the marks secured in End-Sem. of HC-I+HC-II+HC-III+HC-IV}}{320 \text{ (sum of the Max. marks of End-Sem.)}} \times 80$

For Practical Subjects

(FM=80 for one paper)

Average of End-Sem. marks = $\frac{\text{Sum of the marks secured in End-Sem. of HC-I+HC-II+HC-III}}{240 \text{ (sum of the Max. marks of End-Sem.)}} \times 80$

- For PG students with Practical Paper i.e. Marks secured in HC-IV will be posted against the End Semester mark of other Practical Paper HC-VI (Practical).
